Are You Eligibile?

You are eligible if you are a high school senior, full-time college student with one or more years of undergraduate or graduate work remaining, or an adult returning to college to further your career within the food industry.

Must be: (a) employed in the food industry or (b) a direct relative* of a current organizational member of the Illuminators, Illuminators Educational Foundation, California Grocers Association, or Western Association of Food Chains. *Direct relative is defined as an aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, child, sibling or grandchild.

Selection Criteria for all scholarship candidates (\$2,500 University level and \$1,000 community college level scholarships):

- 1. Overall analysis of H.S./college GPA,
- 2. School and/or community activities
- 3. Moral Character
- 4. Essay or video as described in section, "What is the Scholarship election process?"

Once a recipient has been selected and has enrolled in an accredited college or university, the award will be deposited with the Registrar or Bursar's of the college or university. The funds will be applied against the recipient's education expenses for tuition, fees, books, etc. The funds must be used within a 12 month period from the date announced. U.S. legal residents only.
